106-09-2020 REGULATIONS FOR LOT # 5 640 667 (SAND BAY WATER FRONT)

Whereas, the Municipality of Clarendon intends to provide clarification as to the ownership and uses of lot # 5 640 667

Whereas, the Municipality of Clarendon has a clear deed of ownership for lot # 5 640 667

Whereas, the Municipality of Clarendon has tolerated public use of this property for various activities

Whereas, the Municipality of Clarendon has not granted any rights of ownership to any parties as described under article 924 of the Civil code of Quebec

Whereas, the Municipality of Clarendon wishes this property to be used to promote physical and cultural activity among all residents of Clarendon

Whereas the following regulations are intended for use of lot # 5 640 667 only and do not apply to any other area within the Municipality

It is therefore

Moved by: Cr.Smith

Seconded by Cr.Elliott

And unanimously agreed to implement the following regulations:

1. No permanent or semi-permanent structures including but not limited to gazebos, benches, boats, canoes or huts will be installed on the property without authorization
2. No BBQ or other cooking equipment will be used on the property
3. Any animals walking on this property must be on a leash and be supervised at all times
4. Motor vehicles are not authorized unless the resident has received authorization from the Municipality of Clarendon in advance.
5. Fireworks are not permitted unless there has been prior approval obtained from both the Municipality of Clarendon and the Shawville/Clarendon Fire Chief.
6. No fires
7. No unauthorized storage
8. Use of the area is NOT restricted to Sand Bay residents
9. Docks will only be allowed in designated areas. These areas will be determined by the Municipality of Clarendon. Installation and removal dates will be determined by the Municipality on an annual basis.
10. Public parking will be permitted on adjacent streets
11. Scheduled events must receive authorization from the Municipality of Clarendon prior to the date of the event.

Failure by residents to adhere to these regulations may result in a permanent closure of the area.
