

**BY-LAW # 002-05-2014 = FIRES IN A SCREENED-IN OUTDOOR APPLIANCE**

1. Screened Appliance must be made of non combustible materials
2. Fires must be contained in the appliance
3. Volume of material burning shall not exceed 24x24x24 inches (60x60x60cm)
4. Appliance must be attended at all times
5. Appliance must be located on a non combustible surface extended beyond the appliance to the dimension equal to the height of the appliance
6. Appliance must be a minimum of 4 meters (13 feet) from any combustible material – i.e. buildings, fences trees, and also from property lines and roads
7. If the top of the appliance is made of screen, the screen has to be small enough to act as a spark arrest
8. Only unprocessed wood is allowed to be burned
9. "Nuisance" = excessive smoke or smell from the fire is not allowed
10. Out of control fires are subject to a fine of \$100.00 & the total costs of extinguishing the fire i.e.- truck cost of \$150.00 per hour and manpower per hour up to as many as 20-30 fire fighters @ 2 hr. Minimum call in. Minimum fire calls usually exceed \$1,000,.00 (One thousand dollars)
11. The present by-law abrogates in every respect any other previous versions dealing with the topic and will have precedence over all other previous provisions contrary to this By-Law
12. This present by-law will come into force according to law
